2018 Tuscarawas Soil & Water Conservation District Coloring Contest Rules

The coloring contest theme is “**Watersheds our Water, our Home**”.
(NACD 2018 Soil Stewardship theme.)

The contest is open to all **children ages 5-7** in public, private and home school students in Tuscarawas County.

Contest Rules:

- A completed entry form must be attached to the back of the coloring page.
- Coloring sheets should be packaged to remain flat when sent for judging.
- All coloring sheets must be completed by an individual student rather than a team of students.
- All entries must be postmarked or delivered personally to the Tuscarawas Soil and Water Conservation District office by 4:00 p.m. **Oct 5, 2018**.
- The coloring sheets may be used for public relations and/or advertisement purposes.
- Coloring sheets are considered property of the Tuscarawas Soil and Water Conservation District and will **not** be returned.

Coloring Sheet Evaluation:

- Visual effectiveness 75%
- Originality 25%

Awards:

- The artist of the winning coloring sheet will receive a \$25.00 gift card.
- The artist of the second highest scoring coloring sheet will receive a \$15.00 gift card.
